Did you know that there are bluebirds right here in this neighborhood? Maybe you have seen these beautiful birds as they fly through your yard, or stop for a drink from your birdbath. Perhaps you even have a birdhouse somewhere on your property. I currently have bluebird houses set up on my own property, but have noticed that many people in the neighborhood with the perfect spot for a bluebird house do not have one. It may be because they didn't realize that bluebirds were nesting nearby, or because they thought setting up a house would be expensive or time-consuming.



Since bluebirds are territorial, I am limited in the number of nestboxes I can install on my own property. I would love to help more bluebirds than I have room for. If you would be interested, I'd be happy to install a nestbox on your property and monitor it for you weekly during the breeding season. Each week a written record is made of the state of the box and its occupants. I would also be glad to show the nest, eggs, and baby birds to you and your family as they hatch and begin to grow. This is a fine way for children and adults to enjoy nature and learn about conserving a very beautiful bird.
