Did you know that there are bluebirds right here in this neighborhood? Maybe you have seen these beautiful birds as they fly through your yard, or stop for a drink from your birdbath. Perhaps you even have a birdhouse somewhere on your property. I currently have bluebird houses set up on my own property, but have noticed that many people in the neighborhood with the perfect spot for a bluebird house do not have one. It may be because they didn't realize that bluebirds were nesting nearby, or because they thought setting up a house would be expensive or time-consuming.



Since bluebirds are territorial, I am limited in the number of nestboxes I can install on my own property. I would love to help more bluebirds than I have room for. I can help you determine what boxes might be suitable, suggest some inexpensive mounting methods, and help you find a good place to mount your nestbox.
